In addition to providing the top ways to find funding for educational technology and tips for writing effective grants, we have researched the top national education grants that can assist you with purchasing technology for your classrooms.

1. [The Foundation Directory](#) makes it easy to turn foundations into funders. This resource allows you to search for foundations that are most likely to give you grants.
2. [Grants.gov](#) allows you to search and apply for grants. There are various types of grants and it allows you to narrow your search down based on needs. Please note that while you may be looking for technology grants, if you come across a grant that another department can use, it may free up school funding for your needs.
3. [Laura Bush Foundation Grants: For Libraries](#) tends to change based on the current needs across the nation, but for example, their current grant subject is “Rebuilding Libraries after the 2017 disasters”. If the current program does not apply to you, please continue to check back.
